- No lame, blind, injured, sick or substituted animals will be loaded on road transport to ship or holding facility.
- To the best of my knowledge, livestock sources for export comply with the Australian food safety requirements, including standards for chemical residues or environmental contaminants.
- П I declare that the animals described above have been vaccinated against Botulism whilst on the property at least once in their lifetime.

#### I further declare;

- The property has remained free from clinical or visible evidence of Leptospirosis and Leptospirosis & Bluetongue have not been official reported during the 3 (three) years prior to shipment.
- П The property and cattle residing on the property have been free of any known outbreaks or clinical symptoms for at least 3 (three) prior to shipment from the following diseases: Mucosal disease/Bovine Virus Diarrhea (MD/BVD), 'Q' Fever, intestinal salmonella infections (Salmonellosis), Vibrionic Dysentery, Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis (IBR), Infectious Pustular Vulvo-vaginitis (IPV), Cysticercosis, Genital Campylbacteriosis (Vibriosis), Theileriasis, Sporadic Bovine Encephalomyelitis, Ephemeral Fever, Harmorrhagic Septicaemia, Tetnus, Malignant Oedema, Blackleg, Pulpy Kidney, Black Disease, Botulism, Bovine Malignant Catarrh, Anaplasmosis, Babesiosis, Anthrax, Bluetongue, Actinomycosis.
- The property has been free from clinical or visible evidence of Enzootic Bovine Leucosis for the last 3 (three) years.
- The property has been free from clinical or visible evidence of Johne's Disease for the last 5 (five) years.
- The property is currently free from clinical or visible evidence of any outbreaks of the following contagious conditions: Contagious Ophthalmia (pinkeye), Dermatophilosis, Trichophytosis (ringworm).
- The property is currently free from clinical or visible evidence of any outbreak of Tuberculosis in the past 18 (eighteen) months.
- П The property is officially classed free of *Bovine Brucellosis*.
- The animals have been kept since birth or for at least 6 (six) months prior to export in Australia where no cases of Contagious Bovine Pleuropneumonia, *Rinderpest or foot and mouth disease* were reported during the 1 (one) year period prior to export.
- The animals have never been fed with any kind of processed animal proteins.
- The animals originated from an establishment of farm where no cases of Hendra Virus has occurred during the last 6 (six) months prior to export.
- The animals originated from an establishment of farm which there was no reports of Gential Campylobacteriosis and Trichomoniasis during the 12 (twelve) months prior to the export date.
- П No cattle are within a withholding period or export slaughter interval for Antibiotics. The cattle do not contain hormone growth promotant residues at levels harmful to human health as determined by Codex Alimentarius Food Safety Standards.

The original is then to be attached to the Waybills and handed to transport driver for carriage to registered depot. It is a requirement of the Australian Livestock Export Standards (Version 2.3, April 2011 S3.12) "when receiving an identifying livestock depot operator must obtain a copy of Vendor Declarations regarding the property of source and health status of livestock before accepting the livestock for the purpose of preparation for export"

Please note: You are advised that this document will be presented to a DAFF Certifying Officer for the purpose of the Export Control Act No.47 of 1982 as amended. Giving false or misleading information is an offence with penalties of up to 5 years imprisonment.
